Peer-reviewed and accepted full-journal manuscripts will be immediately published online in JAE under J-stage, Japan's largest platform for academic e-journals. Detailed information of the two types of manuscripts is shown below.

✓ Full-journal manuscript

Full-journal manuscripts must contain new and timely contributions from any areas of atmospheric electricity and related fields, and can be submitted anytime.

✓ Short manuscript

Short manuscripts present details of the research results reported in SAEJ's annual meetings which are basically held in January of every year. A short manuscript must be equal to or less than four pages on its first submission. The due date of the first submission is the end of May every year. Peer-reviewed and accepted short manuscripts will be published in October.

Manuscript preparation
